NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 3rd May 1971

S.O. 1914.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of article 77 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Government of India (Allocation of Business) (Eighty-eight Amendment) Rules, 1971.
