NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of article 77 of the constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Government of India (Allocation of Business) (Two hundred and fourteenth Amendment) Rules, 1991.
(2) They shall come into force at once.
2. In the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961,--
 - I. in the First Schedule, under the heading "Ministry of Agriculture (Krishi Mantralaya)", after sub-heading (iv), the following shall be added, namely:-
 - (v) Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (Pashupalan aur Dairy Vibhag)";
 - II. in the Second Schedule, under the heading "MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (KRISHI MANTRALAYA)",
 - (1) under the sub-heading "A. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION (KRISHI AUR SAHAKARITA VIBHAG)", --
 - (a) for entry 5, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"5. Industries, the control of which by the Union is declared by Parliament by law to be expedient in public interest; as far as these relate to:-

(a) Development of agricultural industries including machinery, fertilizer and seeds but excluding cotton, ginning and pressing with the limitation that in regard to the development of agricultural industries, including machinery and fertilizer, the functions of the Department of Agriculture and Cooperation (Krishi aur Sahakarita Vibhag) do not go further than the formulation of demands and the fixation of targets;

(b) Shellac Industry";

(b) for entry 7, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"7. Agricultural Census";

(c) for entry 10, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"10. Matters relating to damage to crops due to natural calamities";

(d) for entry 16, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"16. Professions (excluding Veterinary Practice)";

(e) for entry 17, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"17. Prevention of the extention from one State to another of infectious or contagious diseases or pests affecting plants including locusts";

(f) for entry 29, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"29. Insurance (Crops)";

(g) entries 20,21,25,26 and 38 shall be omitted;

(2) after the sub-heading "D. DEPARTMENT OF FERTILIZERS (URVARAK VIBHAG)", and the entries thereunder, the following sub-heading and entries shall be added, namely:-

"E. DEPARTMENT OF ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (PASHUPALAN AUR DAIRY VIBHAG)

P A R T - I

The following subjects which fall within List I of the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India:-

1. Industries, the control of which by the Union is declared by Parliament by law to be expedient in Public interest as far as these relate to development of cattlefeed with the limitation that in regard to the development of industries, the functions of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (Pashupalan aur Dairy Vibhag) do not go further than the formulation of demand and fixation of targets.

P A R T . . II

The following subjects which fall within List III of the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India (as regards legislation only):-

4. Profession of Veterinary Practice.
5. Prevention of the extension from one State to another of infectious or contagious diseases or pests affecting animals.
6. Pattern of financial assistance to various State Undertakings Dairy Development Schemes either through their own agencies or through the Co-operative Unions.
7. Operation Flood Programme and all matters pertaining thereto.
8. Technology Mission on Dairy Development.

P A R T . . III

For the Union territories the subjects mentioned in parts I and II above, so far as they exist in regard to these territories and, in addition, to the following subjects which fall within List II of the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India:-

9. Preservation, protection and improvement of stocks and prevention of animal diseases; Veterinary training and practice.

11. Insurance (Cattle).

12. Matters relating to animal husbandry including (a) pounds and cattle trespass; (b) cattle utilisation and slaughter.
