NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 11th April 1962

S.O. 1140.—The following Order made by the President on April 9, 1962, is published for general information:—

ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of article 77 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes, with effect from the tenth day of April, 1962, the following amendments in the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961, namely:—

In the said Rules—

(A) in the First Schedule,

(a) in entry 1, for sub-entry (1), namely "Department of Commerce", the following sub-entry shall be substituted, namely:—

"(i) Department of International Trade.";

(b) for entries 14 and 15, namely, "Ministry of Railways (Railway Board)" and "Ministry of Rehabilitation", the following entries shall be substituted, namely:—

"14. Ministry of Mines & Fuel.

15. Ministry of Railways (Railway Board).";

(c) for entry 17, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:—

"17. Ministry of Steel & Heavy Industries

(i) Department of Iron & Steel,

(ii) Department of Heavy Industries.";

(B) in the Second Schedule,—

(a) for the heading "Department of Commerce" and the entries under that heading, the following heading and entries shall be substituted, namely:—

"Department of International Trade" and the entries given in Appendix I to this Order;

(b) for the entries under the heading "Department of Industry", the entries given in Appendix II to the Order shall be substituted;

- (c) after the entries under the heading "Legislative Department" and before the heading "Ministry of Railways (Railway Board)", the following heading and entries shall be inserted, namely:—
"Ministry of Mines & Fuel"; and entries as under the existing heading "Department of Mines & Fuel.";
- (d) the heading "Ministry of Rehabilitation" and the entries under that heading shall be omitted;
- (e) for the heading "Ministry of Steel, Mines & Fuel", the following heading shall be substituted, namely:—
"Ministry of Steel & Heavy Industries."
- (f) for the heading "Department of Mines & Fuel" and the entries under that heading, the following heading and entries shall be substituted, namely:—
"Department of Heavy Industries"; and entries as given in Appendix III to this Order;
- (g) between the heading "Ministry of Works, Housing and Supply" and the entries under that heading, the following heading shall be inserted, namely:—
"A. Department of Works, Housing & Supply.";
- (h) after the entries under the new heading "A. Department of Works, Housing & Supply" and before the heading "Department of Atomic Energy" the following heading and entries shall be inserted, namely:—
"B. Department of Rehabilitation"; and entries as under the existing heading "Ministry of Rehabilitation."
