S.O. 2054.—The following Order made by the President on July 10, 1963, is published for general information:—

ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of article 77 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes, with immediate effect, the following amendments in the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961, namely:—

In the said Rules—

(A) in the First Schedule.

- (a) entry 1 shall be omitted;
- (b) entries 2, 3 and 3A shall be renumbered as 1, 2 and 3 respectively;
- (c) between entries 9 and 10, the following entry shall be inserted, namely:—
  - “9A. Ministry of Industry
  - (i) Department of Industry
  - (ii) Department of Company Law Administration”; and
- (d) between entries 10 and 11, the following entry shall be inserted, namely:—
  - “10A. Ministry of International Trade.”.

(B) in the Second Schedule,

- (a) the heading “Ministry of Commerce and Industry” and the entries under it shall be omitted;
- (b) after the entries under the heading “Ministry of Home Affairs” and before the heading “Ministry of Information and Broadcasting”, the following heading and entries shall be inserted, namely:—
  - “Ministry of Industry” and the entries given in Appendix I and Appendix II to this Order; and
- (c) after the entries under the heading “Ministry of Information and Broadcasting” and before the heading “Ministry of Irrigation and Power”, the following heading and entries shall be inserted, namely:—
  - “Ministry of International Trade” and the entries given in Appendix III to this Order.
