OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Close coordination between Central Ministries and States/UTs for timely implementation of Government programmes, infrastructure projects and development initiatives through the eSamiksha.

The undersigned is directed to say that close and effective coordination between Government of India and States/ Union Territories is of utmost importance to resolve issues hindering progress of important Government programmes/ projects and development initiatives; and to ensure their timely implementation. Cabinet Secretary had written to all Secretaries to Government of India, as well as to the Chief Secretaries of all States and Administrators/ Advisors to the Administrators of Union Territories in this regard on 12.11.2020 (copies enclosed).

2. To facilitate quick resolution of bottlenecks in implementation of Government programmes/ projects, a dedicated module was created on e-Samiksha in 2014. Ministries/ Departments were advised to identify major issues inhibiting implementation of important projects/ programmes, and to take up such issues with respective States/ UTs for quick resolution through the said module. Similarly, it was suggested that the issues reported by States/ UTs on the eSamiksha portal should also be addressed on priority, and a proper mechanism put in place to regularly review the progress.

3. For a more effective utilization of this portal, it is requested once again that appropriate instructions be issued to all concerned to utilize the portal for listing fresh issues and to facilitate time bound resolution of issues listed therein.

Dear Secretary

As you are aware, close coordination between Government of India and States/UTs is of paramount importance for successful implementation of Government programmes, infrastructure projects and other developmental initiatives. In this regard, timely resolution of issues that may impede the progress is critical.

2. To facilitate quick resolution of such matters, a special module was created on e-Samiksha portal in 2014. The then Cabinet Secretary had written to you in this regard (copy of letter enclosed). The e-Samiksha online module is available for Central Ministries/Departments and State Governments to upload fresh issues and update the status of existing ones enabling real time monitoring. The designated nodal officers in each Ministry/Department and State Government are expected to regularly update the entries relevant to them, and in any case by the 5th of every month. The progress of implementation is regularly reviewed by this office. It is observed, however, that the Ministries/Departments are not utilizing this mechanism effectively.

3. It may be ensured that issues hampering implementation of important projects/ programmes are identified and taken up with respective States/UTs for resolution through the e-Samiksha portal. It would be desirable to take up only major issues such as pending clearances, land acquisition matters etc. and not routine matters. Similarly matters raised by States/UTs may also be addressed on priority. An appropriate mechanism may also be put in place to regularly review the progress. This would also be monitored by this office and reviewed in coordination meetings with Ministries/Departments and State Governments.

4. I request you to kindly give personal attention to this matter so that issues impeding progress of important programmes and projects are addressed in a timely manner.

Dear Secretary,

As you are aware, the Prime Minister has stressed upon the need for expeditious resolution of pending issues between Centre and State Governments. In this regard, a system of regular coordination meetings with the State Governments exists in the Cabinet Secretariat.

In order to streamline the system, the web-based system *e-SamikSha* (website <http://cabsecmis.gov.in>) has been upgraded to include online monitoring of resolution of issues between Central and State Governments. Fresh issues can be entered in the system and the status of existing issues can be monitored on a real time, online basis. The user-id/password for accessing the system has already been issued to the Ministry/Department.

It is requested that the issues pending with different State Governments may be entered/ updated in the system by 22.9.2014 this time and, at least by 5th of every month, on a regular basis.
