**Subject: Bills pending due to dissolution of the Fifteenth Lok Sabha**

The undersigned is directed to say that the Bills that had been cleared by the Cabinet in the recent past and are yet to be enacted as laws will need to be placed before the Cabinet for a decision as to whether these Bills are to be pursued in their present form or any changes are required to be carried out therein. Similarly, a view will need to be taken about the Ordinances promulgated by the President and the Bills that have lapsed as a result of the dissolution of the Lok Sabha. These will now be required to be placed for consideration of the Cabinet. The Ministries/Departments may in all such cases take a view in the matter with the approval of the new Minister-in-charge as soon as the new Government is sworn in and thereafter bring suitable proposal(s) for consideration of the Cabinet after requisite inter-Ministerial consultations.
